Via Highway 7 (from Ottawa and the East, or Peterborough and the West):

- Turn off at St Lawrence Street West

Via Highway 401 (from Belleville, Toronto, Kingston, Montreal, etc.):

- Take Highway 62 North all the way into Madoc, and turn left at the four-way stop in town onto St. Lawrence Street West

We are located on the South side of St. Lawrence Street West, opposite Foley Bus Lines.
